War Horse Place Breeding Shed Requirements and Policies

BREEDING SHED WILL OPEN FEBRUARY 16, 2009 AND CLOSE June 26th, 2009

Breeding Sessions: 8:00 AM, 2:00 PM and 6:00 PM

Breeding Shed requirements:

- * All maiden mares must be jumped **PRIOR** to their first visit.
- * All mares must have proper identification (halter nameplate or neckstrap with name).
- * All mares must have a **vet statement** verifying that the mare has been vaccinated for Equine Herpes Virus Type 1 (i.e. Rhinomune, Pneumobort-K etc.) between 7-90 days of being covered.
- * All state and federal requirements must be met.
- * War Horse Place LLC will make every reasonable attempt to breed your mare but reserves the right to refuse the breeding if the mare is deemed dangerous to the stallion or the staff.
- * Mares must arrive at the breeding shed promptly for their scheduled session.
- * Foal heat breeds are discouraged prior to April 1st. A Breeding Soundness Certificate will be required for all foal heat breeds.
- * No foal heat doubles allowed.
- * War Horse Office must have received a Mare Information Sheet for the 2009 breeding season prior to booking.
- * **A breeding shed form must accompany the mare each time she is brought to the breeding shed.**

Mare Requirements:

- * **Domestic Maiden Mares:** A negative aerobic uterine culture is required within 30 days prior to their first visit. A negative aerobic uterine culture is required for a third visit and every subsequent visit thereafter. Maidens must be jumped prior to first visit.
- * **Domestic Barren Mares:** A negative aerobic uterine culture is required within 30 days prior to their first visit. A negative aerobic uterine culture is required for a third visit and every subsequent visit thereafter.
- * **Foaling Mares:** No culture is required for the first visit. A negative aerobic culture is required for a second visit and every subsequent visit thereafter.
- * **All Imported Mares:** Contact the State Veterinarians Office in Frankfort, KY regarding the testing procedures and acquisition of quarantine releases for the 2009 breeding season. A copy of the Quarantine Release, including the results of the CEM endometrium culture, must accompany the mare on her first trip to the breeding shed. The first three mares bred after the imported mare must be CF blood tested 15-25 days post breeding. All maidens must have a negative aerobic uterine culture within 30 days prior to the first visit and a negative aerobic uterine culture is required for a third visit and every subsequent visit thereafter. For foaling mares, a negative aerobic uterine culture is required on the second visit and every subsequent visit thereafter.
